

## HCPC Meeting Minutes- April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2023

Present: all except Rebecca, Elizabeth, Tawnya on phone. No agenda. Meeting began at 1227 hours.

- April meeting had 70 attendees, earned \$318 from raffle, speaker had good content/lacking in presentation, sponsor- Liz- was great.
