Parkinson's Conference- Our annual Parkinson's Conference is a day long conference focusing on families and caregivers of those with Parkinson's Disease. HCPC Partners with the American Parkinson's Disease Association Northwest Chapter to put on this event. Last year we had approx. 200 attendees. The committee will be working to find topics and speakers that are of interest to the audience, as well as finding

Pierce County Caregiver Conference- This event is in partnership with Pierce County Aging and Disability Resources. The event is aimed at caregivers who are caring for a family member or friend. Bob was a leader in our industry and the community, this award honors his memory and thanks people who work tirelessly to improve the lives of seniors in our community.
